

Phonics Screening Check

The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It will identify pupils who need extra help to improve their decoding skills. It is taken in June at the end of Year One.

The table below shows the percentage of children who passed the Phonics Screening Check.
